

Public Notice

Asbestos:

The East Haddam Public Schools, in accordance with the Local Education Agency requirements under the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) semi-annually inspects the condition of all asbestos containing building materials in its school buildings. The findings of the inspections are kept on file in the East Haddam Public Schools' Business Office, located at 26 Plains Rd, Moodus, CT 06469. Arrangements to review the documents should be made by contacting Robert Carroll, School Business Manager, at the above listed address or by telephone at 860-873-5090.

Pesticides:

The East Haddam Public Schools has adopted an integrated pest management policy for pest control within the building and on the grounds of the East Haddam Public School. Pesticide products may be applied by schedule or for preventative or residual control of insect, weed and/or plant disease pests.

Pesticide applications will not be performed within any building or on the grounds of the school during regular school hours or during planned activities unless an emergency application is necessary to eliminate an immediate threat to human health. When this occurs, all children and staff will be removed from the area and not allowed to return until it is safe to do so according to the pesticide label.

Parents, guardians and staff who would like to receive prior notice of pesticide applications may register to receive such notice by contacting Robert Carroll, School Business Manager, P.O. Box 401, Moodus, CT 06469 or by telephone at 860-873-5090.

Registrants will be notified by mail so that it is received no later than twenty-four hours prior to a pesticide application. Notification will include (1) the name of the active ingredient of the pesticide being applied, (2) the target pest, (3) the location of the application on the school property, (4) the date of the application, and (5) the name of the school administrator or a designee who may be contacted for further information.

Registrants will be notified of any emergency pesticide applications that are made to eliminate an immediate threat to human health on or before the date of the application either verbally or in writing depending upon the circumstances of the emergency application.
